### ***Rides program***

Each day, we'll meet in the McLaren Vale Lakeside Caravan Park car-park close to the boom gates.

#### **Arrival Day One - Monday 22 September 2025**

Meet at 3pm for 3.15pm start

A short 25km 'post check-in' afternoon ride - 306m - 100% paved

#### Day Two - Tuesday 23 September 2025

Meet at 9am for 9.30am start

A 45km loop ride out to the Mount Compass region with refreshment stop at Harvest the Fleurieu and back via Willunga - 643m - 69% paved, 31% unpaved

#### Day Three - Wednesday 24 September 2025

Meet at 9am for 9.30am start

A 45.6km loop ride out towards Port Willunga with extensive coastline views and back via some wetlands - refreshment stops at Star of Greece Cafe and Willunga - 345m - 94% paved, 6% unpaved

#### Day Four - Thursday 25 September 2025

Meet at 9am for 9.30am start

A 50km scenic loop ride out to Prospect Hill with coffee-stop at McLaren Flat General Store and lunch at Prospect Hill - 633m - 46% paved, 54% unpaved

#### Useful notes:

- The cycling terrain will be a mix of paved and unpaved surfaces - therefore, **suit gravel bikes and e-bikes**
- Expect a few hills, and some downhill thrills!
- A large shopping centre (Coles, Foodland, Liquorland, BWS and a bakery) is close to the caravan park and the Shiraz Trail, at 130 Main Road, McLaren Vale
- Neutral Spares **Bicycle Workshop** is also in close proximity at 119 Main Road, McLaren Vale

#### Don't forget to bring:

- Usual cycling gear but bring warm clothing and wet-weather items just in case (hoping we get good weather)
- Your own snacks and lunch items for ride days
- BBQ item and drinks for optional Arrival Day One Monday evening
- Helmet, cycling gloves, water bottle
- Mobile, phone charger-cord, power-bank

I will be camping in the unpowered campsite area, campsite no. 13
